



Who is next? (state of negotiations)

- On March 25, 2024 COM and the Republic of Korea concluded the negotiations on the agreement association Korea to Horizon Europe. (Pillar II from 2025 onwards)
- Exploratory talks with Japan have been closed on 12 September 2022 and the two sides
 are currently intensifying preparatory technical discussions in view of a potential launch of
 formal negotiations.
- In March 2024 Egypt expressed interest in association to Horizon Europe by sending a formal letter of intent, exploratory talks are at present under preparation.
- Singapore expressed its interest to launch exploratory discussions on association in April 2024.
